Flyer # 1: (Cake Decorating Class)

- *Does the topic work for a windshield flyer?*

No, I don't think this works for a windshield flyer. It's more a flyer to hang on a window or door of a shop.

Yes, this flyer is eye catching. One thing that caught my eye was the shading style in the back, and also bordering the pictures with two different colors.
